Subject:- Notification of the qualifications for recruitment and method of recruitment in respect of gazetted posts/faculty posts in Government Ayurvedic Medical College Cum Hospital, Akhnoor, Jammu.

WHEREAS, Vide Government Order No. 69-JK (HME) of 2020 dated 20.01.2020, 271 posts of different categories were created for Government Ayurvedic Medical College cum Hospital, Akhnoor, Jammu and Government Unani Medical College cum Hospital , Ganderbal, Kashmir. Out of 271 posts, 142 posts have been created for Government Ayurvedic Medical College Cum Hospital, Akhnoor, Jammu with the following break up:-

AND WHEREAS , out of above, 142 posts, 56 posts belong to Gazetted category and rest 86 posts to non-gazetted category.

AND WHEREAS , in order to make the Government Ayurvedic Medical College, Cum Hospital, Akhnoor, Jammu, properly functional with the adequate staff, the Health and Medical Education Department initiated an exercise to formulate the recruitment rules in respect of the gazetted posts/faculty posts for this institution;

AND WHEREAS , the draft of these rules was discussed in the meeting of the Standing Committee of the ARI & Trainings Department, held on 07.02.2020 and after clearance, these rules have been referred to the Jammu and Kashmir public Service Commission for concurrence, which is awaited from the Commission.

AND WHEREAS , after concurrence by the J&K Public Service commission, the draft Government Ayurvedic Medical College cum Hospital, Akhnoor, Jammu (Gazetted) Service Recruitment Rules, 2020 require the vetting by the Department of Law, Justice and parliamentary Affairs and subsequent placement before the Competent Authority, for approval to their issuance;

AND WHEREAS , such an exercise is likely to take some time. On the other hand the Government Ayurvedic Medical College Cum Hospital, Akhnoor, Jammu is fully commissioned for all the four batches of the courses. The institution is presently functioning on the basis of deployments made from time to time by the Government from amongst the officers of the Indian System of Medicines Department as a temporary measure;

AND WHEREAS, there emerged a dire need to have the gazetted/ faculty posts in the Government Ayurvedic Medical College Cum Hospital Akhnoor, Jammu, been filled up in accordance with the CCIM norms, which necessitated to notify the qualifications for recruitment and method of recruitment in respect of these posts;

Now, therefore, the minimum qualifications for recruitment and method of recruitment are hereby notified in respect of the gazetted level posts/faculty posts of Government Ayurvedic Medical College Cum Hospital, Akhnoor, Jammu, as per **Annexure "A"** to this Government order.
