**Sub: Advertisement for establishment of sheep/goat units under various schemes for the financial year 2022-23.**

Applications on prescribed formats are invited from interested persons or sheep/goat breeders of district Ganderbal for establishment of sheep/goat units under following schemes for the financial year 2022-23:

- Establishment of Sheep/goat unit on participatory mode under ISDS comprising of 10 ewes/does.
- Establishment of sheep/goat units (20-100 ewes/ does) under ISDS on 50% subsidy mode.
- Establishment of shearing units under ISDS on 50% subsidy mode.
- Establishment of Retrieval units (10 ewes only) under RKVY.

#### HOW TO APPLY:

- The application forms can be received from the Office of the under signed (Room no. 357, Mini Secretariat Ganderbal) on working days during office hours.
- The application forms, duly filled in all respects along with relevant documents shall be received by Office of the District Sheep Husbandry Officer, Ganderbal (Room no. 357, Mini Secretariat Ganderbal) only up to 27-06-2022.

#### DOCUMENTS TO BE ENCLOSED WITH THE APPLICATION:

- Adhar card copy.
- Ration card copy.
- Copy of land record holding (Revenue documents).
- Pan card copy (in case of ISDS subsidy and shearing units).
- Photograph of livestock shed (attested by PRI member)
- Category certificate copy (SC/ST/BPL/AAW/EWS), (if applied in any category)
- Bank passbook copy (in case of ISDS Subsidy and shearing units).

#### GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR ALL SCHEMES:

- Applicant must be within the age group of 18-60 years.
- Mere acceptance of the application form does not entitle the applicant to a sheep unit.
- Beneficiaries/households who have already availed benefit under any income generation scheme of Sheep Husbandry Department are not eligible.
- Government employees/Semi government employees/PSU employees/Bank employees are not eligible for the said schemes.
- Applicant can apply for availing benefit under one scheme/component of the scheme only.
- More than one application shall not be entertained from same household.
- Efforts will be made to cover 20% SC/ST and 10% women beneficiaries in the ISDS scheme.
- The number of units (fresh) to be established shall be subject to availability of funds.
- The candidate if found eligible, shall be considered for selection by a designated selection committee through a proper procedure as deemed fit by the committee.
- The acceptance of applications for further course of action shall be subject to preliminary techno feasibility by the concerned authorities.
- Efforts shall be made to cover the sheep/ goat farmers of the district who have suffered loss of livestock on account of natural calamities for the establishment of unit under ISDS scheme.
- Applications of individuals who have been blacklisted by the department in the past shall be rejected.
- The final allotment of units shall be subject to the final techno feasibility report of the designated committee.

#### SCHEME WISE BRIEF GUIDELINES:

##### I) INTEGRATED SHEEP DEVELOPMENT SCHEME:

##### a) Establishment of Sheep/Goat units on participatory mode under ISDS comprising of 10 ewes/ does:

- Any individual/ group of individuals/ self help groups/co operative society/farmer producer organization can avail the benefits of the scheme. Applicant must have sufficient land holding, infrastructure, fodder/grazing and manpower resources available to maintain the unit on organized pattern.
- The selected beneficiary shall be provided a unit of 10 sheep/ goats after executing an agreement (as per prescribed format) to the effect that the beneficiary will return 2 ewes/does out of progeny (at a breedable age of 1.5 to 2 years and a minimum body weight of 25-30kg) to the department as the case may be from 3rd year for next 5 years, will furnish an affidavit duly attested by 1st class magistrate as per the prescribed format, will submit guarantee statement as per prescribed format and will insure animals from 2nd year onwards till he/she is in contract with the department. Further, he/she shall nominate the dependent for ensuring phased retrieval for continuation of the scheme in case of his/her death.
- Due care shall be taken to involve the persons among the BPL/AAW/EWS categories to uplift these sectors of the society.

##### b) Establishment of Sheep/ goat units (20-100 ewes/ does) under ISDS on 50% subsidy mode:

- Sheep/goat unit would mean a unit of min 20 sheep/goats. The subsidy is fixed for 1 unit of 20 animals. However if an entrepreneur sets up multiple units of 20 sheep/goat, he/she shall be accordingly entitled to subsidy in multiples of that available to single unit of 20 sheep/goat.
- 50% of the unit cost as total eligible subsidy will be provided to the beneficiary with a ceiling of Rs. 1.00 lac per unit (20 sheep/goat) whichever is less, and 50% of the transportation cost and insurance premium for the first year with a maximum ceiling of Rs. 10,000 per unit (20 sheep/goat).
- Beneficiary can opt for bank loan facility by depositing 10% marginal money. In such case the eligible subsidy amount will be released to lending bank as back end subsidy.
- The livestock (sheep/goat) shall be inducted from outside the UT of J&K preferably from Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand or similar states to ensure better adaptability.
- The selected beneficiaries who fail to establish the unit within the specified time frame as provided by the department shall be rejected and the next in line beneficiaries shall be considered for the unit establishment.

##### c) Establishment of Shearing units under ISDS on 50% subsidy mode:

- Shearing unit would mean a unit comprising of one shearing machine, genset & shearing spares required to undertake the activity.
- The beneficiary can purchase shearing equipment from any registered company/ authorized dealer/ distributor, sole manufacturer within or outside UT of J&K. However, the rates shall be as per the company rate list or less. The machinery/ equipment shall be certified as per requisite safety/ quality standards.
- Once the beneficiary has procured the shearing unit, 50% of the unit cost as total eligible subsidy with a ceiling of Rs. 0.75 lac per unit, whichever is less, shall be released in favour of the concerned beneficiary.
- Beneficiary can opt for bank loan facility by depositing 10% marginal money. In such case the eligible subsidy amount will be released to lending bank as back end subsidy.

##### II) ESTABLISHMENT OF RETRIEVAL UNITS (10 EWES ONLY) UNDER RKVY:

- 10 ewes shall be provided to the beneficiary free of cost, and from 3rd year of establishment the department shall retrieve 2 ewes/does from each breeder for the next five years. The progeny to be received should be 1.5 to 2 years of age with a minimum body weight of 25 kgs.
- Unemployed youth, marginal/small farmers with less livestock holdings having.
  - Minimum wherewithal viz, land, shed, livestock etc
  - Experience/ knowledge of the trade
- The selected beneficiary shall be provided unit after executing an agreement that he/she will not sell the parent livestock upto five years, abide by instructions/technical advice of the department with regard to scientific management of the farm and return 2 ewes per year out of progeny to the department from 3rd year for next five years
- The selected beneficiary shall submit guarantee statement as per prescribed format and insure the animals till he/she is in contract with the department. Further, he/she shall nominate the dependent who will be responsible for ensuring phased retrieval for continuation of the scheme in case of his/her death.
