The appointees shall report to the Additional Secretary to the Government, General Administration Department (Establishment), within a period of twenty one (21) days from the date of issuance of this order and such candidates who fail to join within the stipulated time, shall forego their right to appointment, and the same shall be deemed to have been accepted ab-initio without any further Notice.

The appointees shall be allowed to join only on the production of the following certificates (in original) to be verified subsequently:

- Academic/Technical Qualification Certificate.
- Matriculation/Date of Birth Certificate.
- Health Certificate issued by the Chief Medical Officer.
- Domicile Certificate issued by the Competent Authority.
- Certificates from the District Industries Centre (DIC) and District Employment & Counseling Centre to the effect that no loan under any self employment scheme has been availed by the appointee.

The appointment of the above candidates shall further be subject to the following conditions:

- Each appointee shall give an undertaking in the shape of an Affidavit to the effect that if on verification, higher Qualification and Date of Birth Certificates from the Concerned issuing authorities are found falsified, his/her appointment as Junior Stenographer in the J&K Secretariat (Subordinate) Service shall be deemed to have been cancelled ab-initio and the legal action as warranted under rules shall be initiated against his/her.
- The salary of the appointees shall not be drawn and disbursed to them unless the satisfactory reports in respect of genuineness of Qualification and Date of Birth Certificates are received from the concerned authorities/agency.
- The appointee shall be on probation for a period of two years.
- The appointment of the candidate shall be governed by the New Pension Scheme² as notified vide SPO-400 of 2009 dated 24.12.2008.
- The inter-se seniority of the appointees in the J&K Secretariat (Subordinate) Service shall be determined as per the J&K Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1958.
- The appointment of the above candidates shall be subject to outcome of writ petition(s), if any, pending before Competent Court of law.
