Subject: Release of Admit Cards to the candidates for Physical Standard Test (PST)/Physical Endurance Test (PET) for the post of Constables (Armed/IRP/SDRF/Executive), advertised vide Notification No. 01 of 2024, Item Nos. 01, 02, 05, 06.

1. In continuation to this office Notice No. JKSSB-COE0EXAM(UT)/36/2024-03 (7593651) dated: 29-07-2025, it is hereby notified for the information of the candidates that the Physical Standard Test (PST)/Physical Endurance Test (PET) for the post of Constables (Armed/IRP/SDRF/Executive), advertised vide Notification No. 01 of 2024, Item Nos. 01, 02, 05, 06 shall be held from **19th August, 2025** and onwards at Bakshi Stadium, Srinagar of those candidates who had opted for **Kashmir Division as test venue**:
2. It is further notified that:-
 - i. Admit Cards for the candidates appearing for the PST/PET shall be hosted on official website of JKSSB (www.jkssb.nic.in) from 12-08-2025.
 - ii. Candidates can download their Admit Cards from the official website of JKSSB by using their Application Id. They must read the instructions contained therein, carefully.
 - iii. In case of any difficulty in downloading/issues related to Admit Card, candidate(s) may contact the JKSSB Help-Desk at 0191-2461335 (Jammu)/0194-2435089 (Srinagar), during office hours.
 - iv. The candidature of candidates claiming eligibility by misrepresentation/concealment of any material facts, impersonation, fraud, etc. shall be liable for cancellation and disciplinary action, as deemed appropriate.
 - v. The Board reserves the right to cancel the candidature of any candidate at any stage at which he/she is found ineligible.
 - vi. The candidates are also advised to visit the JKSSB's official website (www.jkssb.nic.in) for the latest updates on the examinations and Admit cards will not be sent by post.
 - vii. It is notified for the information of all the shortlisted **Ex-Servicemen (ESM)** candidates, who are appearing for the PST/PET to bring the Matriculation certificate (as age proof) mandatorily on the day of PST/PET along with other supporting documents. No ESM candidates shall be allowed to appear in the PST/PET without the production of relevant documents ~~at~~ the time of the test.
 - viii. It is notified for the information of all the shortlisted candidates belonging to the **Gorkha Community and Bot Tribe**, who are appearing for the PST/PET to bring the category certificate (Gorkha/Bot community certificate issued by the competent authority) mandatorily on the day of PST/PET along with other supporting documents to avail the benefits of the relaxed standard of PST, if any.
 - ix. Candidates are required to appear in the PST/PET on the schedule date, time and venue. A candidate, who fails to appear in the PST/PET on the given date, shall forfeit his/her right of consideration at any stage.

- x. In case of any deficiency with reference to eligibility etc., proved at the time of PST/PET, the candidate shall not be allowed to appear in the PST/PET. If any deficiency is found subsequently, the candidate shall not be considered for selection and will be treated as disqualified.
 - xi. Any candidate found guilty of impersonating or submitting fabricated/tampered documents/testimonials or making false and incorrect statements or suppressing material information shall render him/her liable for criminal prosecution under law, which shall include permanent debarment or debarment for a specific period, for consideration of any or all recruitments, made by the Board. Also canvassing/lobbying in any form will entail disqualification of the candidate.
 - xii. The Board reserves the right to cancel the candidature of any candidate at any stage at which he/she is found ineligible in terms of the Rules/Regulations.
 - xiii. Any candidate found misleading the Board/Committee(s) by trying to appear more than once, in the PST/PET shall be liable for prosecution under norms.
 - xiv. The PST/PET is of qualifying nature only.
 - xv. No TA/DA shall be paid for participation in the PST/PET.
3. Stepwise procedure to download JKSSB E-Admit Card:
- i. To download E-Admit Card, first visit the official website of JKSSB, i.e., www.jkssb.nic.in.
 - ii. On the homepage, there will be an option to download **E-Admit Card**.
 - iii. On that page, click on the link/button - "**LOGIN**".
 - iv. Enter log-in credentials, i.e., **Application Id**.
 - v. Click on the '**View and Print E-Admit Card**' button.
 - vi. The JKSSB E-Admit Card will appear on the screen.
 - vii. Candidate must bring the clear printed copy of the E-admit card on the day of their PST/PET.
 - viii. Download and Print your JKSSB E-admit card.
